## QUESTIONS FOR 2009 NAR DIRECTOR CANDIDATES

**Candidate's Name:** Jan Ellngson

1. At NAR meetings, what would you do if the issue on the floor is inconsistent with the state Association's views or position? Could you present Washington REALTORS' views on the subject?
  1. I will be an advocate for issues that affect Washington REALTORS® at NAR. I can best do that in committees, forums, and in conversations with Realtors I have built relationships with nationwide.
  2. I have always been at the ready to express Washington State's views which I have demonstrated in the committees I have served on.
  
2. In which national committees are you interested, and in which committees would you strive to become a member? What would you do with your time when you are not attending committee meetings?
  1. I am most interested in the Issues Mobilization and State and Local Issues committees. I have served on both, along with four years on the Housing Needs Committee. I also have a commitment to Professional Standards and hope to serve as the state representative next year.
  2. As in the past, I would use my spare time to attend other meetings to keep up on the latest information available that I can bring to our state. I also work on creating relationships with members from all over the country.
  
3. Describe your area of interest and your past involvement with the state Association. Within that expertise, what would be your three-year vision as NAR Director and how would it benefit Washington REALTORS?
  1. My areas of interest are Government Affairs and Education. My three year goal would be to continue seeking opportunities to serve on Issues Mobilization, whether on the committee or a task force. Through the efforts of former NAR Directors, this committee has brought real benefit to Washington State.
  2. The information I gain from the GA committees at NAR teaches me what benefits and programs I can bring to our state issues. I have learned a lot about the grant programs we can tap into at NAR which benefit our issues here in Washington.
  
4. How will you identify and put forth the issues that are important to our Association and how will you communicate that information to the membership?
  1. As in the past, I have voiced my concerns relative to issues facing Washington State. The most recent issue being FEMA's plan to remap Washington State's frequently flooded areas. This would cause grave consequences to the affordability of housing in Washington, and to our Quality of Life goals.
  2. I have previously worked on creating relationships with committee chairs, which gets our issues heard before the committee. I plan to continue that practice in the future.
  
5. How will you communicate the information on issues brought forth at NAR meetings to the membership?
  1. I will provide reports that outline what issues were discussed and how they affect Washington State.
  2. I will report to the NAR Directors at the caucuses.
